TUITION:

Resident Camper - \$360.00 (includes room and 11 meals)

Commuter - \$280.00 (includes 7 meals)

Additional fee for Resident Campers ONLY:

Room Key Deposit - \$5.00 CASH - do not include in tuition payment – due the first day of camp – will be returned when the key is turned in at the close of camp.

The camp will include sessions on conducting, teaching and leadership for Drum Majors and Technical Training, Performance Quality, Development of Movement skills and Individual and Ensemble Confidence for Color Guard. A demonstration of the skills learned during camp will be presented on **Thursday**. Family members and guests are welcome to attend this performance. **Camp will conclude at 12:00 noon on Thursday.**

All campers will be served dinner on Sunday, lunch **and** dinner on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. Boarders will be served breakfast on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. **Lunch will not be served on Thursday.**

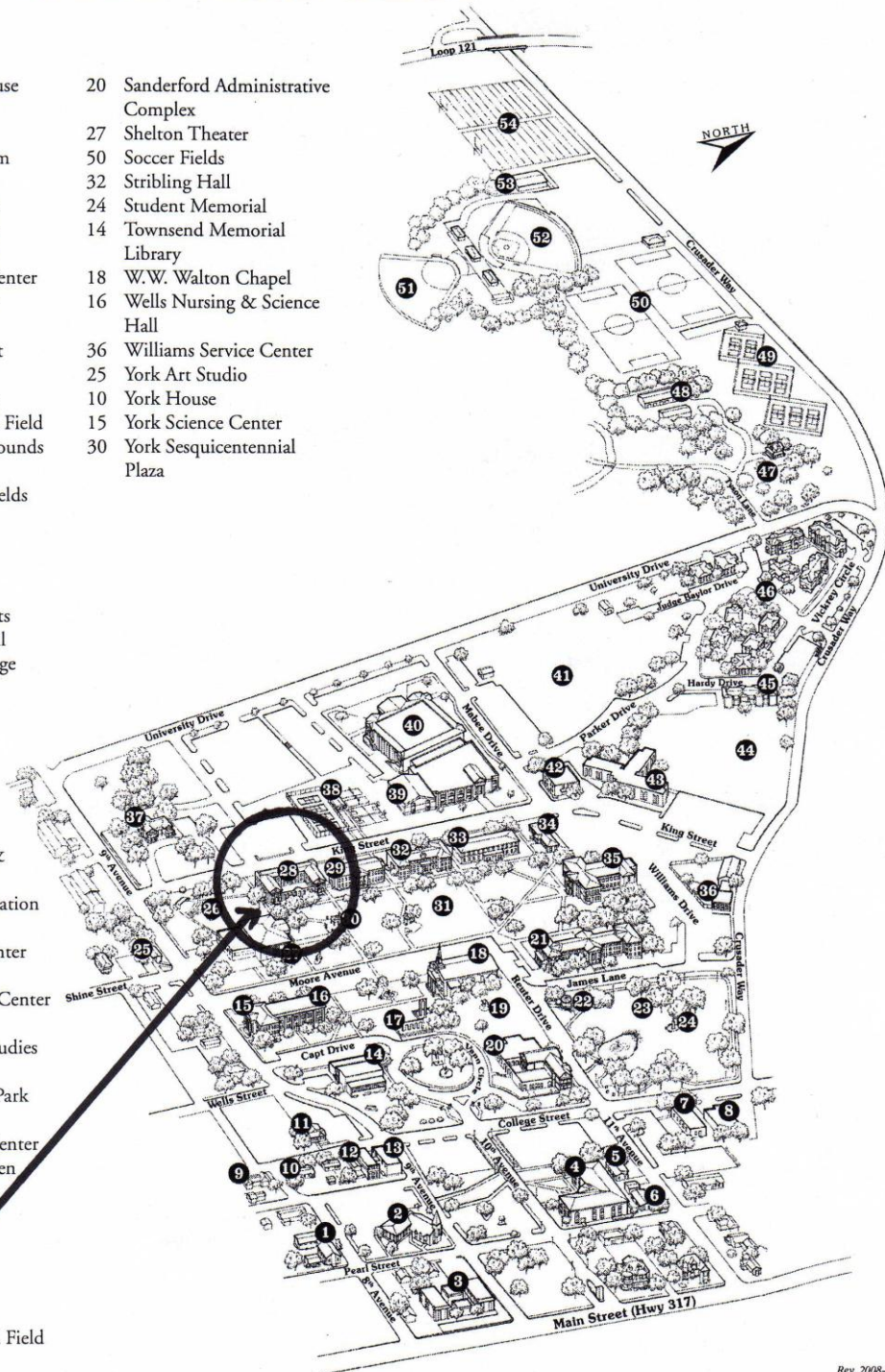
